5. Software Installation

➤ Windows 98SE:

- 1) The system will detect the hub and run “Add New Hardware Wizard.”
- 2) Press “Next” to proceed to the next screen.



- 3) Check the box to “Search for the best driver for your device” and press “Next”.



- 4) Leave all fields unchecked and press “Next” to advance to the next screen.



- 5) As you see the following screen, please press “Next”.



- 6) As you see the following screen, please press “Finish”.

6. Verification

You can verify successful installation of your 7-Port USB 2.0 Hub by clicking on “My Computer” then “View system information” then “Device Manager”. You should see “Universal Serial Bus Controllers” in the “Device Manager” sheet.
